The Business Times Budding Artists Fund (BT BAF), which was launched by The Old Parliament House Limited and adopted by The Business Times in 2005, originated from a conviction that no child with strong interest and potential in the arts should be denied of the opportunity to develop his or her talents due to a lack of financial resources.

Students under the Financial Assistance Scheme may apply to The Business Times Budding Artists Fund to receive fully-sponsored Arts education at The Little Arts Academy (LAA). Applicants must be a Singaporean citizen or Permanent Resident, and show an interest in the arts. If your child is eligible, a copy of the application form will be given to your child separately.

The application closes on Sun, 30 April 2017, for the cohort starting their lessons at LAA on 1 July 2017. Successful applicants will be notified and they are required to attend a compulsory orientation in June. Applicants who miss this deadline will be considered for the next intake in Jan 2018.

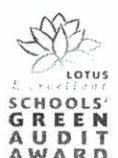

- to develop students' social emotional learning competencies, environmental awareness and outdoor skills





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
The schedule is as follows:
