You are required to **respond through the SNAC app** to inform your child's form teacher of the reason for the absence. Your child's attendance status will be updated by his/her form teacher upon receiving your response. We understand that some parents may not own a smartphone or the recommended smartphone devices. Thus, you may also email your child's form teacher of his/her absence if you do not have access to the SNAC app.





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In the event that your child has to miss school for a valid reason, please produce a medical certificate or a letter of documentation on the next day when he/she reports to school.
