Please refer to the dates for the SA1 as stated in Appendix 1. The format and topics to be tested have been uploaded on the school website. (Refer to T2W1 notification.) We appreciate if you would monitor your child's / ward's work and give him/her all the support.

Pupils are expected to bring the required examination tools (e.g. calculator, 2B pencil, mathematical instruments, and dictionary) for their examination. The school will not provide pupils with any examination tool during the examination. Please take note on the use of calculators and dictionaries for the following examinations:

Subjects	Details
Mathematics / Fdn Mathematics	Approved calculators are only allowed in P5 & P6 <u>Paper 2</u> . They are not allowed for the other levels and papers.
Mother Tongue Subjects	Approved dictionaries are only allowed for P3 to P6 <u>Paper 1</u> . They are not allowed in Paper 2.

Pupils who are absent due to medical reasons or other valid reasons (VR) must submit a medical certificate or letter of excuse to their Form Teacher upon their return. Medical certificate must be produced in order for the teacher to key in 'VR' in the report book. There will be no make-up examination. Pupils who are absent without a valid reason will not be awarded any marks for the paper which they have missed. The teacher will key in 'AB' in the report book.
