E. Primary 3 & 4 Ukulele Module

(Miss Tabitha Chew, Teacher-in-charge)

The ukulele module is a new music programme initiative for all P3 & P4 students. The ukulele has become increasingly popular in recent times because of its size and its unique sound. It is easier to learn and serves as a good stepping stone for pupils to learn the guitar at P5. As part of our broad-based arts approach, this programme is aimed at introducing pupils to the ukulele instrument through a 16 lesson module at P3 & P4. The module will give pupils a better understanding of the anatomy of the ukulele, the various chord progressions and using the instrument to express themselves through music. The module will be conducted in-house by our trained music teachers. Through this module, we will build our pupils' foundation in rhythm and their aural abilities. The Primary 3s will be starting their ukulele lessons in Term 3, while the Primary 4s ukulele lessons are already ongoing.

In this programme, pupils will learn how to:

- identify the parts of the ukulele
- learn at least 4 chords on the ukulele
- perform at least 3 songs on the ukulele
- learn at least 3 strumming patterns

Students who are interested in purchasing Ukuleles for practice at home may do so on the **21st of April 2016** during their recess. The cost of a concert-sized ukulele will be between \$40 and \$80.
