Greetings from Park View Primary School!

A. NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATIONS

The school will be celebrating National Day on **Thursday, 8 August 2024**.

On this special occasion, our school is aiming to break the Singapore Book of Records (SBOR) for the largest display of heart-shaped painting on miniature canvas (Art) and Largest Cultured Milk Bottle Shaker Ensemble (Music).

The objectives are:

- To promote environmental conservation through recycling
- To enhance our school environment by adding color, vibrancy, and character
- To foster camaraderie among our students, staff, and stakeholders as we collaboratively work towards a common goal

We have also invited our community partners – Sparkletots Preschool Pasir Ris West, Cherie Hearts, Cerebral Palsy Alliance Singapore (CPAS) and Tampines Meridian Junior College (TMJC) to join us in this record-breaking attempt.

We hope this event will also serve as an opportunity for our parents to inculcate the importance of conservation and how everyday trash can be repurposed into beautiful and functional objects.

To date, we have 525 artworks painted, and we will continue to work towards our target of 1819 mini canvas. We have also made a total of 1,245 music shakers to date. These achievements are made possible by the collective efforts of our Park View students, parents, alumni and community partners.
