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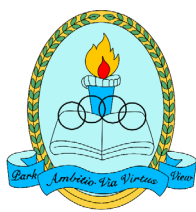

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B. [P1 TO P5] HOME-BASED LEARNING (HBL)

Please be informed that our P6 students will be having their PSLE Listening Comprehension examination on **Friday, 13th September 2024** and their PSLE written examinations from **Thursday, 26th September to Wednesday, 2nd October 2024**.

During this period, our school will implement HBL for P1 to P5 students on the following dates:

Friday, 27 th September	Primary 3 and 4
Monday, 30 th September	Primary 1 and 2
Tuesday, 1 st October	Primary 3 and 4

During the Home-Based Learning period, students are strongly encouraged to remain at home and complete the assigned work. For parents/guardians who require in-school support during the HBL days, please kindly inform your child's Form Teacher. The Student Care Centre in school will also remain open in the afternoons for enrolled students from 1.30pm to 7.00pm during the Home-Based Learning period.

C. [P6] 2024 PSLE LISTENING COMPREHENSION (LC) EXAMINATION

The PSLE LC Exam will be conducted on **Friday 13th September 2024**.

- All P6 students are required to report to school by **8.00 a.m.** except for those who are exempted from Mother Tongue Languages (MTL).
- Students who have been granted exemption from MTL are to report at **10.15 a.m.**

Please ensure that your child reports to school punctually. All students will be dismissed after the English Language LC Exam at about 11.50 a.m.

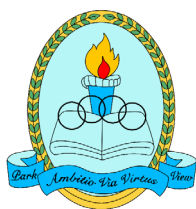
Other important matters:

- Mobile phones, other electronic devices or any unauthorised materials are not allowed in the exam room. Students will need to surrender their mobile phones and other electronic devices to the teachers-in-charge before the exam. They may be barred from taking the exam if found with the devices in the exam room.
- Students will enter/exit via only the school main gate (Gate A).
- There will be a short break after the MTL LC paper. Students may bring their own light snacks for their break. Please note that only the drinks stall in the canteen will be in operation on that day.

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D. [P6] PRE-PSLE STUDY BREAK

The school will be implementing a three-day study break for P6 students from **Monday, 23rd September to Wednesday, 25th September 2024** to support their well-being prior to the PSLE.

During the study break, P6 students are strongly encouraged to remain at home and focus on their revision. The school will remain open for P6 students who require in-school support. Learning support will also be provided to our P6 students via online platforms during the study break, and details will be shared with students closer to the date. In addition, the school may request for selected students to return to school during the study break for additional support. Parents/Guardians of selected students will be informed separately.

Parents/Guardians who are unable to secure alternative care arrangements may continue to send their children/wards to school for supervision via their Form Teachers. The Student Care Centre in school will also remain open in the afternoons for enrolled students from 1.30pm to 7.00pm during the study break.
