A. END-OF-YEAR ORAL EXAMINATIONS FOR P3 TO P5

Our P4 and P5 students will be taking their end-of-year Oral Examinations for English Language (EL) and Mother Tongue (MT) Language on Tuesday, 17th September and Wednesday, 18th September 2024. The Oral Examinations will be conducted from 2.00 pm to 5.00 pm. Details are as follows:

Wednesday, 18th September	P4 Oral [EL] P5 Oral [MT]

Your child/ward will be dismissed once he/she has completed his/her Oral Examinations. Do make your own transport arrangements for your child/ward.

For P3 students, they will take their end-of-year Oral Examinations on Thursday, 26th September (MT) and Monday, 30th September (EL) during curriculum hours.

Please note that there will be no make-up for the Oral Examinations. If your child/ward is absent, a medical certificate is required.

SGSecure focuses on three core actions that every one of us can do during emergencies:

- Staying Alert (Vigilance) to prevent and to keep your family, friends and yourself safe in the event of an emergency.
- Staying United (Cohesion) through building strong ties in the community; cherishing and safeguarding Singapore's racial and religious diversity and harmony so that we can stand together in peacetime and crisis; and
- Staying Strong (Resilience) by being ready to deal with a crisis, being resilient as individuals and as a community, to help each other bounce back quickly after an emergency.
