Assessment is an important part of teaching and learning and provides useful information to your child, your child's teachers and yourself. In school, teachers use a range of formative assessment techniques such as questioning, giving feedback as well as peer and self-assessment to support your child's learning. Bite-sized assessment such as topical reviews, reading tasks and performance tasks are provided for your child as opportunities to experience milestone successes in the learning process to build his confidence and motivation in learning.

The school adopts a range of formative and summative assessments to better enhance the learning and development of our students. These include:

- Primary 1: Holistic Assessment (HA) in Semester 1 and 2 (Non-weighted)
- Primary 2: Holistic Assessment (HA) in Semester 1 and 2 (Non-weighted)
- Primary 3 & 5: Holistic Assessment (HA) in Term 1-3 and Semestral Assessment (SA) in Term 4
- Primary 4: Holistic Assessment (HA) and Semestral Assessments (SA) in Semester 1 and 2
- Primary 6: Continual Assessment (CA) in Term 1, Semestral Assessments (SA) in Semester 1 and Preliminary Exam in Semester 2
