Dear Parents/Guardians,

Greetings from Park View Primary School!

A. [ALL] MATTERS PERTAINING TO COVID-19 SITUATION

From 26 April 2022 onwards, Singapore's COVID-19 situation will step down to DORSCON Yellow with further easing of community safe management measures (SMM).

1) Stopping Health Risk Notices (HRNs)

Ministry of Health (MOH) will stop issuing HRNs to close contacts from 26 April 2022. However, we should continue to exercise social responsibility. For example, if there is anyone in the household that is tested to be Covid-positive, please take necessary precautions to test your child/ward and ensure that they are negative before leaving their homes, to prevent further spread. If your child/ward is feeling unwell (e.g. sore throat, fever or cough), please bring him/her to see a doctor and do not come to school. Do inform the form teacher on the reason for your child/ward's absence.

2) Stepping down of TraceTogether (TT) and SafeEntry (SE)

SE check-ins in schools are no longer required. Students are strongly encouraged to hold on to their TT tokens, so that the government may rapidly step up contact tracing should there be any need, e.g. in the event of the next Variant of Concern.

B. [ALL] PARENT-TEACHER-CONFERENCING (PTC)

There will be a Parent-Teacher-Conferencing (PTC) session on Friday 27th May 2022 from 8.00am to 4.30pm via Zoom. The objectives of the PTC are to strengthen the home-school partnership and to provide a platform for you to meet up with teachers to discuss the holistic development of your child.

The time allocated for the meeting with the respective form/subject teachers is 15 minutes each. Registration for the PTC will be done through Parents Gateway and will open from 17th May to 24th May.

We seek your understanding that booking of time slots will be carried out on a first-come-first-served basis and is strictly by appointment. Please make your booking by Tuesday 24th May 2022, 5pm.

More information on booking via Parents Gateway will be sent at a later date.
